WHEREAS "First PARTY" a company registered under the Companies Act, 2013 and engaged in the field of medical education having its trade name "MediColl Learning Private Limited".

WHEREAS "Second Party" is a medical practitioner, who works as Clinical Trainer for the Observership in Diabetes Mellitus/Internal Medicine/Family Medicine / Pediatrics -Program and to coordinate the clinical training/ contact program at Major Super Speciality Hospital.

WHEREAS both "MediColl Learning Private Limited" and Major Super Speciality Hospital - reckoning their complementing strengths and capabilities for educational and training of the Student of the First Party, mutually agree to join hands and work together for fulfillment of their respective obligations on the terms and conditions described hereinafter.

This MoU shall not be deemed to constitute any Party hereto the agent or partner of the other Party and nothing in this MoU or in the performance by the parties of their obligations/responsibilities shall be construed so as to create any partnership or association of persons.

(e) ASSIGNABILITY

This MoU and each and every covenant, term and condition hereof shall be binding upon and incur to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective successors and legal assigns, but neither this MoU nor any rights or obligations hereunder shall be assignable directly or indirectly by any Party hereto without the prior written consent of the other Parties, provided that before this MoU is so assigned the assignee, shall execute an MoU to be bound by this MoU in the same manner as the assignor.

(f) SEVERABILITY

In the event that any of the provisions or portions of this MoU are held to be unenforceable or invalid by any duly constituted arbitral panel or Court of competent jurisdiction, the Parties shall negotiate an equitable adjustment in the provisions of this MoU with a view toward effecting the purpose of this MoU, and the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions or portions shall not be affected thereby.
